1. MHRM Distance-Based Program

Anne Lavack recently participated in a phone conversation with Canadian Business magazine which provided excellent PR coverage in the November publication.

Anne Lavack is updating GBUS 838 *Research Methods in Management*, which is scheduled as a distance, web based course for Fall 2007. Students need to be made aware that they cannot finish the MHRM degree in one year. The only way this is possible is if they do a project and take non-HR electives.

2. MBA

There continue to be numerous applicants for the MBA program. The future course schedule has been set up so that it is possible to complete the program in one year. Enrollment for MBA/MHRM is nearly double in comparison to last year.
