The next deadline for the Dean's Research Grant program is **Tuesday, September 8, 2009**. The fund provides financial support for research projects that are intended to result in a peer-reviewed journal publication, and that will have a member of the Faculty of Business Administration as principal investigator.

The maximum amount of the grant is \$5,000, and applicants may receive a maximum of \$5,000 in a given academic year (May 1-April 30). Grants cannot be used for conference travel or for buying teaching release. Faculty members should complete the 2-page Dean's Research Grant application form at:
