Sabbatical Deadline – October 1

The deadline for applying for Sabbatical for the 2011 – 2012 academic year has arrived! If you are applying for Sabbatical you must get your application in to the Dean's Office by October 1, 2010.

Detailed information about sabbaticals is in the URFA Academic Collective Agreement (Article 16.7), but here is some key information.

Eligibility – To be eligible for a twelve-month sabbatical a faculty member must hold an appointment with tenure and have at least six years of continuous employment at the University of Regina. For a subsequent sabbatical, the requirement is at least six years of continuous employment since the last sabbatical for a twelve-month sabbatical or at least three years of continuous employment for a six-month sabbatical.

Application process – To apply for a sabbatical for the 2011-2012 Academic Year a faculty member must complete a Sabbatical Application Form (available on the Faculty's website in the Faculty Information section) and submit it to the Dean's Office by **October 1, 2010**. The application must include a detailed statement of the faculty member's plans for the sabbatical period, indicating the anticipated benefits to the faculty member and to the University.

Other information – Sabbaticals for the 2011-2012 Academic Year can begin either July 1, 2011 or January 1, 2012 for a period of twelve months or six months. Faculty members receive 80% of salary during the 12-month sabbatical period. Alternatively, a faculty member may request a six-month sabbatical at 100% of salary.
