Student Hiring Tips

- Student Research Assistants at the University of Regina belong to CUPE 2419. One of the provisions in the Collective Agreement between the University and CUPE 2419 is that any jobs over 25 hours per semester must be posted for at least a week. Contact **Devon Anderson**, Faculty Administrator, for assistance with the posting **at least** two weeks prior to the date you want the job to begin.
- Although the deadline for students to submit timesheets is the 15th of the month, the deadline to set students up on payroll is earlier. When you've selected a student to fill a position, please provide **Devon Anderson** or **Janeen Brown** with the information needed by the 10th of the month. Information required includes, but is not limited to, student name and address, student email, start and end dates, what fund they will be paid from, and estimated hours of work.
- Please note that students will not be paid if they submit timesheets after the end date of their appointment letters. If you want students to work longer than initially thought, please contact **Devon Anderson** or **Janeen Brown** in order to extend the student's employment. Again, this request needs to be made by the 10th of the month - it cannot be left until the 15th, otherwise students will not be paid on time.
