CFI Grant Success!

The Canadian Foundation for Innovation John R. Evans Leaders Fund (CFI-JELF) has agreed to fund the faculty's new Laboratory for Behavioural Business Research! The project's total value is \$417,781. CFI will contribute \$167,114 (40%) upon confirmation of provincial matching funds (40%). The remaining funds have been committed by the faculty (17%) and in-kind vendor donations (3%). **Lisa Watson** was the primary author of the application on behalf of the faculty as represented by our three official applicants **Sandeep Mishra, Adrian Pitariu** and **Haithem Zourrig**. **Devon Anderson** also played a major role in helping to design the space. Thanks also go to Dean **Andrew Gaudes** for committing to the project regardless of the grant application's success. If you would like more information about the application or the lab itself, please don't hesitate to ask any of those involved! The new lab space will be referred to as the LaBBR lab (pronounced labour) and our current plan is to open for business in Fall 2015!

MBA Study Tour
