Enactus Regina 2015-2016 Success

Enactus Regina's 50 active members have seen an enriching and exciting academic year. They began with the environmental projects of *We-Can* and *Smart End of the Bottle (SEOTB)*, which launched their first bin at the CVA central services. They have now collected over 500 used plastic bottles. All proceeds sponsor children's education.

Their *Breaking Barriers* program was rejuvenated into a one-day seminar, and received wonderful feedback from its 20 international participants, who learned skills such as resume writing techniques, interview etiquette and networking skills.

They also saw great success with their *Tax Solutions* project, which aims to impart financial literacy to fellow peers. The team of 30 dedicated volunteers files free tax returns and educates the individual so that they can do their own tax returns in the future. This year they filed 615 tax returns.

Further, they raised \$9,000 for the *Prince's Operation Entrepreneur* program and assisted 20 Canadian Armed Forces veterans in a weeklong 'business boot camp'. The camp helps veterans to expand their business ventures, and teaches the business skills needed to successfully open and manage their business.

Final Exam Reminder

There are important structures in place to ensure our students are provided opportunity to succeed. Please provide a .pdf of your exam(s) to David or Devon and be prepared to let the office know that you are on campus and available to deliver your exam on the day of the final. Final exam schedules cannot be altered to avoid scheduling conflicts. Alterations to the schedule are the responsibility of the Registrar. Students need time to prepare for finals; therefore, no course work is to be conducted following the last day of classes. No final can be administered until the exam date. Take home exams are to be due at the end of the writing period for the exam. Contact Brian Schumacher if you have any questions.

Deferred Exams

Deferred examinations in the Faculty of Business Administration will be granted for only two reasons (with the appropriate documentation):

1. The student is ill and/or hospitalized during the final examination; or
2. Compassionate reasons.

If a student has a request with another reason that they feel is an exceptional circumstance and wants to submit a deferred exam request, then please talk to Wendy (if available) or Brian (if Wendy is not available) to see how to proceed.

For BUS courses, if a deferred examination is granted, the examination will be written on a date determined by the Faculty. All deferred final exams are normally scheduled on a Friday in the first month following the end of the semester.

Individual instructors cannot make deferrals for final examinations; they must be made by the **Associate Dean** or Designate (**Wendy Tebb**).

If the student is not in our faculty, the student needs to be referred to his/her home faculty for assistance and to submit their request for a deferral.
