Project Readapt, led by Arslan Azeem, focused on its first adaptive product, an adaptive camera rig that affordably allows a regular DSLR camera to be used with the left hand. To our knowledge it is the only left-handed camera solution in existence. Readapt was presented in the entrepreneurship and youth empowerment categories.

An update on the digitization of the team's Financial Foundation project (led by Salmaan Moolla) was presented in the financial literacy category. While both projects are too early in their development to be competitive this year, they got very positive feedback from judges. The team came back motivated to keep the momentum of the two projects going and to develop some exciting new projects to launch next year. ## More Reimbursement Claim Tips

Remember the University's fiscal year-end is April 30, so be sure to get your reimbursement claims for non-tri-council funds in by early April. This includes claims on your APEA, general faculty research funds, and other non-tri-council funds.

For meals/entertainment - please include an itemized receipt as well as proof of payment. If you don't have an itemized receipt, claim the per diem amount, being sure the per diem spreadsheet is attached to the claim. If you are paying for a group, you should include a list of participants and the reason for the meals /entertainment. This can be noted on the back of the receipt.

It's unusual but occasionally there are times when we still have to pay in cash for items and the only option is a hand-written receipt for the purchase. Financial Services will accept hand-written receipts in these cases. The receipt needs to show the vendor name, vendor signature, a dollar amount, what item was purchased and the date.
