REGINA, NOV. 5 - The University of Saskatchewan has announced the establishment of an annual series of lectures designed to enrich its programme for the undergraduate students at the Regina Campus. The lectureship has been named in honor of Dr. Steward Basterfield, former Dean of Regina College, in recognition of his interest in the philosophy and history of science and of his long and valuable service to the University of Saskatchewan. Prominent scholars in the natural sciences will be invited to deliver the Basterfield Lectures.

The Faculty of the Regina Campus believes that special projects such as this lectureship will create an awareness in students of the advancing frontier of knowledge. By stimulating students and faculty alike, the Basterfield Lectures will play an important role in the liberal arts programme.

The first Basterfield Lectures will be presented by Dr. Calvin A. VanderWerf, President of Hope College, Michigan, and formerly Head of the Department of Chemistry at the University of Kansas. He is scheduled to speak in Darke Hall on January 16 and 17, 1964. The public will be invited to attend.
