REGINA, AUGUST 4 - Further academic appointments have been announced for the new bachelor of music course to be introduced this fall at the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus.

It was previously announced that Howard Leyton-Brown, director of the Regina Conservatory of Music, will become director of the bachelor of music course on July 1, and will be given the rank of associate professor.

Three assistant professors have been appointed. They are Gordon McLean, of the Piano Department, Jan Van der Gucht, of the Vocal Department, and Jack Behrens, of the Theory Department, all of the Regina Conservatory of Music, Regina Campus.

Dorothy Bee, Gladys Angley, Elman Lowe and Marguerite Buck, all of the Conservatory, have been named lecturers in music.

Two new positions in woodwind and brass instruments were established and were filled by Mell Chapman Carey and Thomas M. Schudel, both appointed as special lecturers.

All appointments were effective July 1.

The four-year bachelor of music course, which will be introduced this fall, will offer options to meet the particular needs of school music teachers, performers and composers. The aim has been to develop a course of sufficient scope to interest serious students of music and to fit them for a professional career as performers or teachers.
