REGINA, OCT. 2 - The first in the "Plain Talk" series of public meetings will be held on Monday, October 5, at 8 p.m. in the Museum of Natural History Auditorium. Dr. Brock Chisholm will speak on "Our Health and Our Future", and following his talk there will be questions, comment and discussion, according to Dallas W. Smythe, Chairman of the Social Sciences, University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus. Admission will be free.

Dr. Chisholm formerly was Director-General of the World Health Organization. Before that he had been Director-General of Medical Services, Canadian Army. And still earlier, he had been Deputy Minister of Health in the Department of National Health and Welfare. His writings include "Can People Learn to Learn?" and "Prescription for Survival".

"Plain Talk" for 1964-65 will bring six outstanding speakers to Regina to talk on various aspects of the topic, "Toward the Future Society". The University hopes that a regular audience will be drawn for these meetings from teachers in the collegiate institutes and elementary schools, students in collegiates, adults within driving distance of Regina, and its own faculty and students.
