## RELEASE ON RECEIPT

REGINA, NOV. 26 - The date has been set for the first Convocation of the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus.

Dr. W.A. Riddell, principal, Regina Campus, announced today that the historic event will be held the afternoon of Monday, May 17, 1965, in Regina. Students who enrolled this fall in the third year of the College of Arts and Science at Regina campus will be graduating with the bachelor of arts degree. A number of honorary degrees will be awarded.

On the morning of Convocation day the University Senate will meet in Regina. The Senate is the governing body of the University which has broad legislative powers over the academic program.

The University will be holding its spring Convocation in Saskatoon the same week. As in each of the last two years, three ceremonies will be held, the first two on Wednesday, May 19, one in the morning and the other in the afternoon, and the third on Thursday, May 20, in the morning.

The faculty councils at both campuses will meet before the meeting of the Senate and the Convocation ceremonies. The Saskatoon Faculty Council will meet Friday morning, May 14, in Saskatoon. The Regina Campus Faculty Council will hold its meeting the afternoon of the same day in Regina. Dr. J.W.T. Spinks, president of the University, will preside at both meetings.
