Construction of project number 1 at the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus, is expected to move into a very interesting stage early next week, when the erection of pre-cast concrete columns will begin on the laboratory building. As a result, the structure will progress very rapidly during the next twenty days or so. The columns will be erected and bolted into place and then pre-cast spandrels linking the columns will be installed.

If you wish to visit the site when the work gets under way, you may make arrangements with Mr. A.A. McKinnon, Assistant Superintendent of buildings, at the Regina Campus. He will know exactly when the next stage of construction is to begin and will be in a position to provide you with information about construction that you may need.
