2. To change EMBA 870 International Study Tour to a Pass/Fail grading system.
 - a. This is currently set up as a percentage grading system. However, since it replaces part of the EMBA 900 project (which was previously 6 credit hours and is now 3 credit hours), and EMBA 900 is graded as pass/fail, it makes sense that EMBA 870 also be graded as pass/fail.
 - b. Of the 36 credit hours in the EMBA program, that would leave 24 credit hours graded as a percentage, which equals or exceeds the number of credit hours graded as a percentage in most U of Regina graduate programs.

Rationale: This will allow these courses to be included in the Graduate Calendar, making it easier for students to select courses based on published course descriptions.

MOTION 2: To change EMBA 870 International Study Tour to a Pass/Fail grading system. **CARRIED**

Rationale:
