## Pre-requisite Changes

Effective with the registration that is presently taking place for Spring/Summer 2011 and Fall 2011, there are a number of pre-requisite changes that were approved by Faculty Council at the December 2010 and January 2011 meetings. Those that specifically impact the core of the BBA program are:

- **ENG 100** is now a pre-requisite for **BUS 205** (Management Communication), rather than being a pre-requisite for BUS 260 (Intro to Organizational Behaviour). This should better ensure that students have experience with reading and written communication prior to taking BUS 205.
- **BUS 205** (Management Communication) has now been added as a pre-requisite for **BUS 375** (Management Information Systems), along with all other core BUS 200-level classes. This will prevent students from delaying their enrolment in BUS 205, and ensure that they take BUS 205 earlier in their program of studies.
