REGINA, NOV. 6 - The second in the "Plain Talk" series of public meetings will be held on Monday, November 9 at 8:00 p.m. in the Museum of Natural History Auditorium, Regina. Dr. Kenneth E. Boulding will speak on "The 21st Century-- Man's Coming of Age!", and following his talk there will be questions, comment and discussion, according to Dr. Dallas W. Smythe, Chairman of the Social Sciences, University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus. Admission will be free.

Dr. Boulding has been a Professor of Economics at the University of Michigan since 1949. Born and educated in England, he is author of "The Organizational Revolution" and nine other books. A co-founder of the Centre for Conflict Resolution at the University of Michigan, he has written extensively on issues of war and peace, the most recent book being "Conflict and Defense".

The first talk in the PLAIN TALK series by Dr. Brock Chisholm on October 5 attracted more people than the auditorium could accommodate. There remain after the Boulding talk five more PLAIN TALK meetings in the 1964-65 season, including a "bonus" meeting in December for which the name of the speaker will be announced on November 9. As with all meetings in the "Plain Talk" series, the University hopes that teachers in the collegiate institutes and elementary schools, students in collegiates, adults within driving distance of the meeting and its own faculty and students will be in the regular audience.
