Dean's Message

I hope you are all enjoying the good weather we are fortunate to have this past while. I want to provide a brief overview of what I presented at the town hall we had on Friday, June 3.

- First, thank-you to the reappointment committee for the time invested in going through the review process. Being given the mandate of a second term as your Dean is not taken lightly, and every effort will be made to have a second term, which all may deem successful.
- An area, which I've received much feedback, particularly in the context of responses to the engagement survey results, is completing the strategic planning effort our Faculty has undertaken. You will have likely received an email from **Larry Hiles** inviting you to review assembled materials. Please take a moment to read his message and the attachments.
- Some of you may have seen the article regarding the need for space for our organizations. The conversation came out of a presentation at a Chamber luncheon. I had mentioned we need to think about how we've grown out of our space, in size, in complexity, and in presence. We require sufficient space for student-run organizations, as well as common spaces for gathering, collaborating, and engaging. I'd like to start conversations with staff and faculty around the philosophy of our own space, positioning ourselves for a long term objective of a building for the Faculty of Business Administration.
