Tomorrow is the 20th National Aboriginal Day, with events and activities celebrating the history and contributions Indigenous Peoples have made to Canada. I hope you are able to find events in our community and participate. I am proud to inform you that our offering of the Directors Education Program (DEP) through the Institute of Corporate Directors has taken a national lead by offering a half-day session on First Nation and Métis governance. The Levene School hosts the second and third modules of the DEP, with the second module taking place on our campus this weekend. The session on First Nation and Métis governance will take place Friday morning. In addition, all 36 participants and instructors have been invited to a pipe ceremony, taking place Thursday evening at FNU in advance of Module II. The morning will conclude with a traditional First Nations feast. It will be a meaningful way to closing a week, which recognizes the rich traditions of Indigenous Peoples in Canada.
